Improved service continuity and collaboration.

12 MONTH PRIORITY:

Parents are connected to their community.

12 MONTH PRIORITY:

Community members link families to the services and support they need.

OBJECTIVE:

Services and education providers have the knowledge, skills and confidence to meet the individual needs of all children and families.

OBJECTIVE:

Children's services are planned; improved alignment of values, understanding, best practice and processes.

OBJECTIVE:

The right people are at the action and partnership group tables.

OBJECTIVE:

Improved skills and confidence for parents to parent.

OBJECTIVE:

Parents and carers are linked to services and supports that they need.

OBJECTIVE:

Parents and carers understand the 6 ARACY elements of child wellbeing.

OBJECTIVE:

Parents understand the importance of children being connected to community.

OBJECTIVE:

Parents are connected to their community.

OBJECTIVE:

Community members advocate for the needs of children to be reflected in infrastructure and activities.

OBJECTIVE:

Increase community understanding of the needs and rights of children.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Convene and strengthen the Go Goldfields Children & Families Partnership. Amplifying the voices of children and families in Central Goldfields.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Increase attendance of children participating in kindergarten and primary school, and develop a tiered plan for intervention and trial.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Increase participation rates at 2 year key age and stage visits to Maternal Child Health (MCH) - stakeholder group to develop communications strategy and key messaging, and implementation.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Early Years Forum - knowledge sharing space for early years educators and services

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Co-design an approach to provide social connection opportunities for all mothers during pregnancy and in the first year after birth. Implement a trial group to test the approach; being 'The Nest'.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Data collection and analysis, advocacy for evidence based approach to the work.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Implement Test, Try and Learn cycles from prevention and awareness to early intervention actions.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Co-design, develop and implement a trial for a tiered plan for intervention.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Loved & Safe Campaign - Continuation of the communications campaign and 'Build Your Village Here' campaign.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Teddy Bears Picnic - delivery of the annual community event for children and families.

LINKED ACTIVITY:

Actively involve children in consultations and magnify their voices across the work (eg 16 Days of Activism).
