Community is safe and free from violence.

12 MONTH PRIORITY:

Services work together to build workforce capacity, integration and coordination (shared understandings, learnings and leadership).

Community are engaged and actively involved in leading change (shared understanding and learning together, key messaging and leadership).

12 MONTH OBJECTIVE:

Legal assistance, police and courts are accessible, responsive and trusted.

12 MONTH OBJECTIVE:

Family violence support services are visible, accessible and responsive.

12 MONTH OBJECTIVE:

Services have skills, resources and necessary expertise to address family violence.

12 MONTH OBJECTIVE:

Women’s expertise is valued and sought, women are active leaders in the community.

12 MONTH OBJECTIVE:

Women drive change towards gender equity and primary prevention of family violence.

12 MONTH OBJECTIVE:

The community drive change towards gender equity and primary prevention of family violence.
